- Encouraging innovation and adoption of best practices and new patient safety and quality initiatives.
- Providing recognition and support to diffuse best practices in research, education and practice.
- Establishing partnerships, collaborations and strategic alliances to inform our mission and advance common goals.

The ASHP Foundation Benefits Health-System Pharmacists By:

- Offering leadership development opportunities through the Center for Health-System Pharmacy Leadership, including the Pharmacy Leadership Academy, the Pharmacy Leadership Institute, the Leadership Resource Center and the Leadership Speakers' Bureau. This is a joint collaboration with ASHP.
- Supporting practitioners' interest in launching a research career through educational resource sessions on basic research skills, the Research Boot Camp, grant programs geared toward new investigators, residency research tips and a web-based research resource center.
- Encouraging collaborative research with other disciplines.

- Providing continuing educational opportunities through traineeships, which provide pharmacists with the knowledge to care for special patient populations, such as those with pain management challenges or cancer, and to implement medication therapies and protocols in their institutions.
